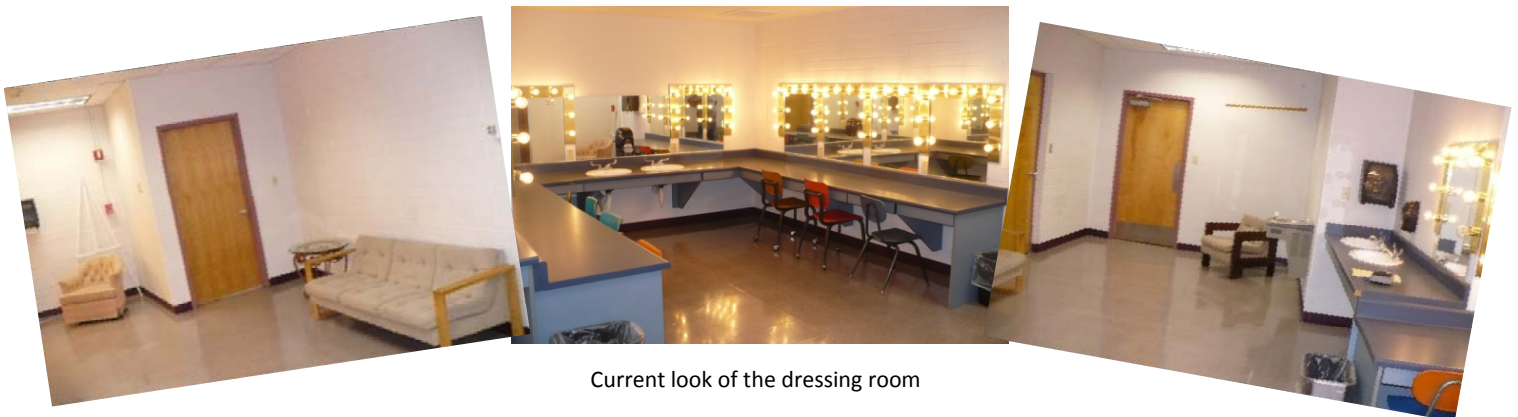


Wes Humphrey Memorial



On May 28, 2012 Wes Humphrey a beloved member of the community passed away. Wes taught music for the Lake Havasu Unified School District for 16 years before retiring in 1989, but he never truly left. In the many years following Wes would come back to teach and substitute for the District. He was also a vital member of the Arts community and helped to expand the District's Performing Arts Center and Little Theater. Wes worked tirelessly throughout the years putting together fundraising efforts to purchase new and updated equipment for the theaters. He never stopped giving back to the District, the students, or the community. Wes, an avid lover of music and a very talented musician himself, was one of the founding members of the Lake Havasu Regional Orchestra and the Lake Havasu Symphonic Winds. In fact, he conducted his last Lake Havasu Symphonic Winds performance in April 2012.

How does a community that benefited from his many efforts to the Arts honor him...a decision was made to dedicate and refurbish the large men's dressing room in the Performing Arts Center in Wes's name. It is estimated the cost will be around \$5,000 to complete this project as we have envisioned it.
