Scope and Parameters

- Assess Community Needs and Priorities
- Identify District Strengths and Weaknesses
 - Vision and Mission – Aggie reviewed history of how we got the Mission Statement through efforts of administration, staff and community members many years ago. It is a good foundation but out dated. Board feels we need to have a short useable statement. Discussion and ideas shared. Suggestion to put document up on white board and go through it – Guiding Principles. Discussion on “What is our philosophy?”, and what critical thinking tools are needed to have a clear and purposeful meaning? Discussion on what our students need to be learning in classrooms – critical thinking, standards, framing the students for success, etc. Continuation on previous discussions: district culture; organizational goals; “grammar, logic, and rhetoric”;

Are we operating as a system?; and meaningful homework. Discussion once more on a one line mission statement (goal); communicating as a District that we are going to try to accomplish this; suggestions were shared. Each person present took several minutes to

write a one line mission statement, then read them out loud without any comments. Discussion on statements, which were given to Nichole to compile and refine. Others will think about what bulleted items could be used to enforce the statement.

➤ Group moved to boardroom to work on a draft Mission Statement. Title was changed to Guiding Principles: removed first two sentences; word/paragraph changes (removing-adding); bulleting; and rearranging was worked on collaboratively. Mrs. Asseier will refine the Draft Guiding Principles and return it to the board for their thoughts.

Mrs. Cohen and Mrs. Asseier will set a time to come back together to finalize the Guiding Principles and continue on with the Board Retreat.
