TOPIC: APPROVAL OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LAKE HAVASU UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT #1 AND THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO HOST STATEWIDE STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM - SYNERGY

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the Governing Board approve the renewal of the Intergovernmental Service Agreement (IGSA) between the Lake Havasu Unified School District #1 and the Arizona Department of Education to host a statewide student information system, Synergy, at an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.

RATIONALE:

In early 2014, the Arizona Department of Education went out to bid for a student management system on behalf of all school districts in Arizona, in an attempt to standardize systems being used to report student data/attendance throughout the State. The bid was awarded to Edupoint/Synergy and is good for ten years from the date of award. On October 6, 2015, the LHUSD#1 governing board approved an IGSA between the District and the ADE.

The price to contract the first year was \$10.00 per student and, at the time of the original approval, the subsequent pricing posted on the ADE website was \$6.50 per student. That pricing has been increased to \$7.50 per student, per the quote attached to this item. Also attached are the original posting on the ADE website and the current pricing that is posted on that site.

An approval amount of \$50,000 is being requested to cover incidentals. Payment will come from District Additional Assistance - Fund 610.

The Governing Board will receive an electronic copy of the IGSA prior to the Board meeting. Public may request an electronic copy of the IGSA from the Superintendent's Office.

This item has been reviewed by the District's purchasing department and by our attorney.

Item was postponed from the February 21, 2017, Governing Board meeting as the Synergy IGSA had not been received from the Arizona Department of Education.
